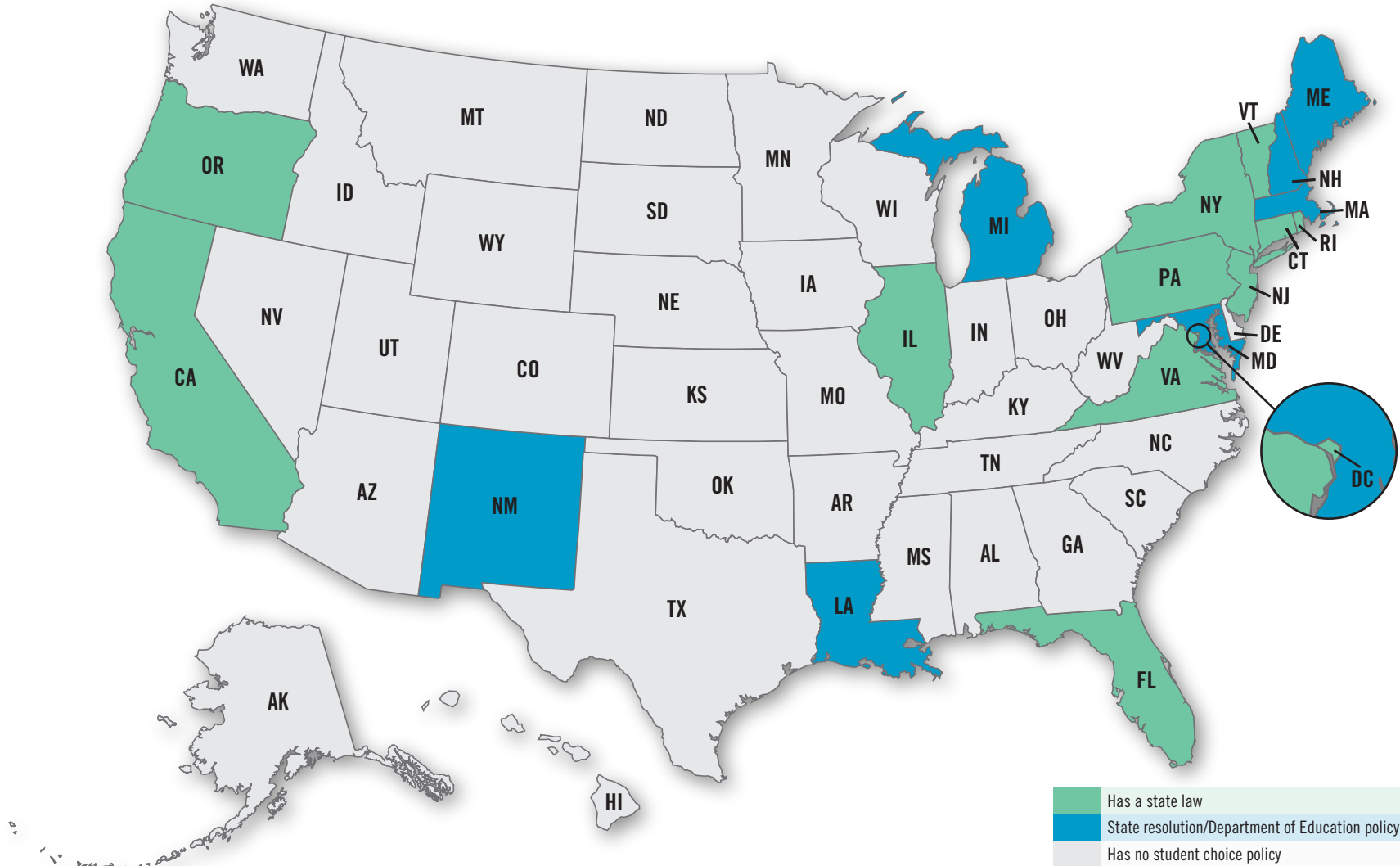


# DISSECTION LEGISLATION
